Old Business:

1. The minutes from the April 2011 minutes were reviewed and approved.
2. Troop Donation Drive; Be there by 4 p.m. on Saturday. Bring out tables from the gym and set them up in the parking lot near the garage, off the church. Guys should be there at 7:30 on Sunday morning to work.
3. Appreciation dinner: Had a good time, barely made any money on the bar/beverage service.
4. Deacon Paul Reception: Another good time. Cindy Harvey made a scrapbook for people to put in photos and write nice things to Deacon Paul. There will probably be some sort of event for his retirement in the fall of 2011.

6. Garage Sale: Rich called the city and one permit will cover everybody at the sale. The scheduled date will be June 25th. Mike Harvey, Rich and Chris will work on a flyer to be handed out at the church. Maybe we could also schedule another sale to participate with the St. Pat's Neighborhood garage sale in the fall. We will sell food at the garage sale, keeping it simple, like hot dogs, chips, pop and water. Space will be sold for \$20 - gets you a 10x10 area - groups doing fund raisers for the Parish will not have to pay the \$20 fee, all others must, including Men's Club members, and members of other Parish organizations who are having a sale to sell their personal goods. The sale will be held on the outside grounds around the school. If it rains it will be moved indoors to the gym and hallway.
